

## DISCUSSION DRAFT OF PMPU NOW AVAILABLE

The Discussion Draft of the Port Master Plan Update (PMPU) is now available for review. The Port is inviting the public to review the full Discussion Draft and provide written comment during a 90-day review period, ending **July 31, 2019**. This is the first time in the Port of San Diego's robust public outreach efforts on the Integrated Planning initiative that the Discussion Draft of the PMPU is available for review.

## WHAT IS THE DISCUSSION DRAFT?

The Discussion Draft of the PMPU is a major milestone for the Integrated Planning effort. The Discussion Draft includes and addresses allowable uses and activities, future development, and management of water and land within the Port's jurisdiction on and around San Diego Bay by providing a mix of goals, policies and standards supported by written narratives, figures and tables. The goals and policy concepts in the document were drafted with review and input by the public, stakeholders and Board of Port Commissioners.

## A CULMINATION OF ROBUST PUBLIC OUTREACH

The Discussion Draft is based on comprehensive analysis and community and stakeholder input, all informed by over six years of collective public outreach, including:

- More than 250 interviews with key stakeholders and partner agencies
- 13 open houses and community meetings
- 36 public Board workshops
- Two online surveys with a combined total of more than 6,300 respondents

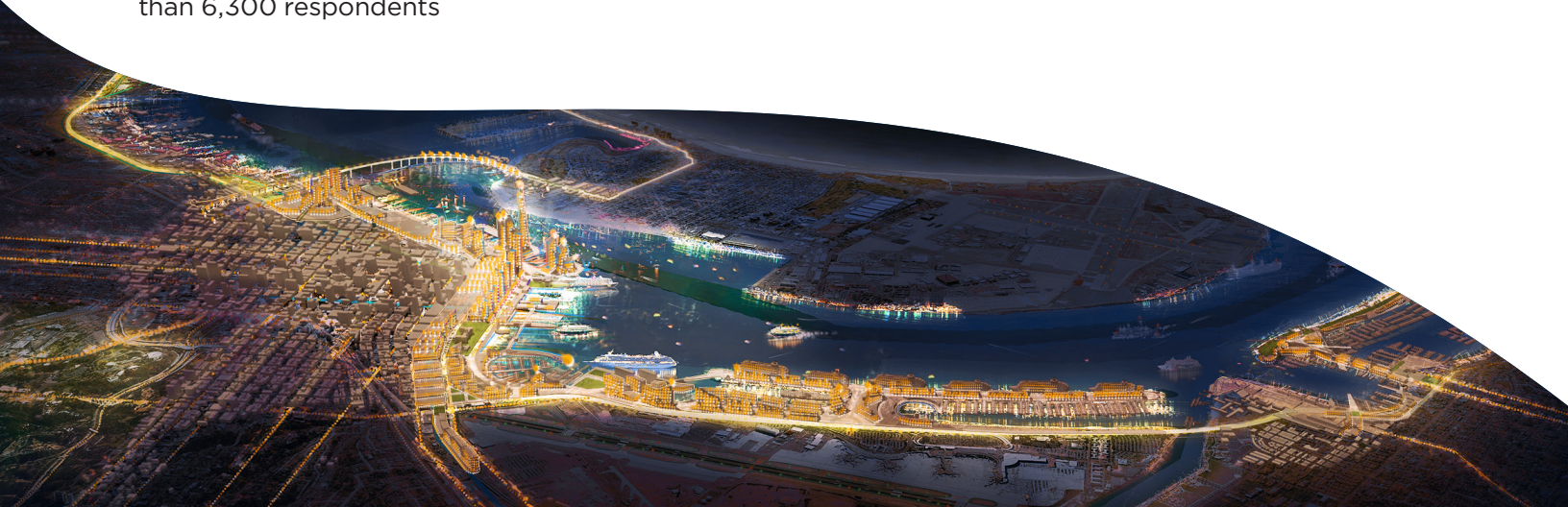
